

- 1. This Invitation for Bids follows the General Procurement Notice for this Project that appeared in Development Business, issued on October 08, 2013.
- 2. The Government of Mozambique has received a Grant from the Nordic Development Fund toward the cost of Transforming Hydrological and Meteorological Services Project (Hydromet) and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this Grant to payments under the Contract for Supply of Meteorological Equipment for National Institute of Meteorology (INAM), Maputo, Mozambique, as detailed in the Schedule of Requirements.
- 3. The Instituto Nacional de Meteorologia, IP (INAM, IP) now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for the supply of **Meteorological Equipment:** for air temperature, soil temperature, pressure, for 155 observation stations, to replace mercury based instruments.
- 4. Bid validity shall be 120 days and maximum delivery period is 90 days.
- 5. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures as specified in the Nordic Development Fund's Guidelines; General Procurement Guidelines for Projects; Section 4 Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consultancy Services.
- 6. The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence to demonstrate that it meets the experience in supply of similar goods and or similar quantities up to two contracts for the past 3 (three)

years, with necessary information for its verification.

Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below on the 11th June, 2021, by 09:40 a.m. Bids must be delivered to the address below.
- 10. All Bids must be accompanied by a *Bid Security of USD 5,000.00 (Five Thousand United States Dollar)* or equivalent in Metical.
